

ASSORTED HIBISCUS

These flowering plants blooming in shades of red, pink, yellow, and orange, but there are also purple, lavender-blue, white, and bicolor varieties available. Some also have variegated foliage that adds appeal.

ASSORTED MANDEVILLA

Bold and showy, Mandevilla definitely makes a dramatic statement in landscapes and container gardens. This tropical vine bears a nonstop supply of large, trumpet-shaped blooms in shades of red, pink, and white. It's also lovely in landscape beds and borders - and is frequently used to climb up and over arbors, trellises, and mailbox posts.

ASSORTED OLEANDER

Oleander has an upright, rounded growth habit with a slightly smaller spread than height. During the warmer months, the shrub is full of showy, five-petaled flowers that grow in clusters on each stem. Toxic to humans and animals if ingested.



We offer deliveries from our full-service fleet. Pricing is based on distance. Customers must supply proper labor & equipment to unload material. The customer has 1 hr to unload pick-up truck/trailer deliveries & 2 hrs to unload a straight truck or tractor-trailer delivery. After allotted times, the customer will be billed \$95 per hour detention charges.

PAYMENTS

We require a completed customer information form to be completed in order to purchase material, regardless of the method of payment. All sales are COD. We accept Cash, Visa, Mastercard, Discover & American Express.

CHECKS

We only accept checks from established customers who have demonstrated a positive payment history. We require a copy of your driver's license and your phone number in order to accept your check. A \$30 service charge is applied to all returned checks. No exceptions. We will not accept 3rd party checks or checks from your customer/client.

CREDIT

Customers with established credit must have a current customer information form on file as well as a signed personal guarantee. All payments are due within the agreed-upon terms. A finance charge of 2% per month will be added to the unpaid balance. We reserve the right to revoke extended credit at any time.

SALES TAX

Under the New Jersey Sales and Use Tax Act, we are required to collect 6.625% sales tax on all gross sales unless we are presented with a valid Sales Exempt Certificate at the time of purchase. Accepted tax forms are:

ST-3- Plant material purchased for resale, not installation.

ST-13- Plant material purchased for use by Federal, State, or Municipal projects.

ST-7- Plant material purchased to be planted and grown on as nursery stock.
